# JOB SUMMARY AND DISTINGUISHING FEATURES:

Under general supervision, performs routine service on automotive and related equipment. Incumbents in this class perform routine and skilled maintenance and repair duties in a training capacity.

**ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:** (All responsibilities may not be performed by all incumbents.)

Performs routine servicing of County automobiles including: changing oil, greasing, and lubricating.

Prepares and refuels automobiles for long and short term use.

Performs Valet service for County automobiles.

Inspects and repairs tires, motor belts, automotive lights, and windshield wipers.

Performs routine safety checks on automobiles and related equipment.

Performs maintenance and janitorial services in the shop and service area.

Maintains records relating to work load.

Assists automotive mechanics with minor repairs and maintenance of vehicles and equipment.

Monitors and assists in scheduling of vehicles for service.

Performs re-stocking and minor inventory control of parts and supplies in the service area.

Provides back up information to mechanics on vehicle and service problems and requests.

Performs brake service on County vehicles, including turning drums and rotors.

Performs front-end alignments.

Answers the telephone by responding directly to calls or routing to appropriate person.

Performs other related duties as assigned.
