THE POSITION

Vacancies in Ukiah and Fort Bragg. The list developed from this recruitment will be used for a limited period to fill regular full-time and/or part-time positions throughout the County, should they occur. Performs complex, professional level counseling services and psychotherapy functions, including: managing cases, initiating crisis management, conducting therapy sessions, and developing new programs. Examples of duties include but are not limited to the following:

- Answer crisis calls; talk with patients, one on one, identify problems and assist patients in reaching goals.
- Conduct evaluations and assessments; provide ongoing supportive therapy; perform court-ordered psychosocial assessments.
- Conduct group therapy sessions; intervene during patient crisis.
- Interview and evaluate client for admittance; determine if client has potential to harm self or others; find board and care placements and other housing for clients; assist clients in obtaining financial resources.
- Participate in treatment team, staff and professional meetings to discuss client progress.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.

JOB REQUIREMENTS AND MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential job function satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. **Minimum Education and Experience Requirements:** Master's degree from an accredited college or university in Social Work, Psychology or related field; or Bachelor's degree when also possessing a Psychiatric Registered Nurse certification, and two to three years of progressively responsible experience, or when also possessing required licensure, a combination of related education, training and experience which provides the required knowledge, skills, and abilities to perform the essential functions of the job. **CA Licenses and Certifications:** Marriage and Family Therapist (or) Licensed Clinical Social Worker (or) Licensed Psychologist (or) Psychiatric Registered Nurse.

Knowledge of:

- Modern methods, techniques and procedures used in marriage, family and child counseling.
- Psychological theory.
- Interviewing techniques; crisis intervention techniques.
- Child and adolescent development; juvenile justice system.
- Ethical and legal management practices; patients legal rights.
- Special education laws pertaining to emotionally disturbed children.

Skill and Ability to:

- Perform advanced counseling and therapeutic processes and procedures; case management; crisis assessment and disposition.
- Observe and record psychiatric behavior; conduct 3632 eligibility evaluations.
- Analyze, evaluate and diagnose situations and adopt effective courses of action.
- Assess and intervene in high-risk situations (suicide, aggression).
- Write clear/concise reports and chart notes in accordance with professional standards, state regulations and department protocol.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

All applications will be reviewed with those judged most qualified progressing further in the selection process. Based on the number of qualified candidates, an oral examination (weight 100) or an unassembled exam, consisting of an evaluation of education and experience as stated on the application form, will be administered. The oral examination will test the knowledge and abilities described above. A passing mark of 70 must be attained for placement on the employment list. **Special Testing:** If you require special testing arrangements to accommodate a disability or religious conviction you must contact Human Resources at (707) 463-4261 prior to the test date to make your requirements known. You must provide enough advance notice to allow Human Resources to properly review and evaluate your request. **Special Requirements:** Employment with Mendocino County may require the successful completion of a pre-employment medical examination and may include drug screening.

APPLICATION AND EXAMINATION PROCESS

The exam process is tentative. Should a change be made, applicants will be notified. The competitive process includes:

1. APPLICATION SUBMISSION

A Mendocino County application must be filled out completely and must clearly demonstrate that the job requirements and qualifications are met. The application must be filed with Human Resources or postmarked no later than the final filling date shown on this announcement. 2. QUALIFICATIONS APPRAISAL

All completed applications will be reviewed. Based on the information provided in the application documents, the best qualified will be invited for further examination.

3. QUALIFICATIONS EXAMINATION

To further assess applicants' possession of required qualifications; the examination process may include one or a combination of: an oral examination, written exam, performance exam, physical ability exam.

4. ELIGIBILITY LIST

Applicants must receive a minimum score of 70 on the examination. Applicants successful in the examination process will be placed on an eligibility list for possible final selection interview. The eligibility list will be used to fill current and future vacancies for a limited period, should they occur.

SALARY

Compensation is based on a five-step salary range, with annual merit-based increases.

MEDICAL, DENTAL & VISION INSURANCE

The County and the employee share the cost of an employee selected health care plan.

LIFE INSURANCE

Coverage of \$20,000 is provided by the County.

SICK LEAVE

Paid sick leave accrues at the rate of 1.25 days per month, or 15 days per year.

HOLIDAYS

Mendocino County observes 11 paid holidays per year. In addition, each employee is granted 24 hours of personal leave time upon the successful completion of the probationary period.

VACATION

Accrues at the rate of two weeks per year for three years. Three weeks per year after three years, four weeks after eight years and five weeks after 15 years.

RETIREMENT

Covered under Social Security and the 1937 act; both employees and the County pay into the retirement fund.
