MENDOCINO LIGHTNING COMPLEX

The Mendocino Lightning Complex has burned approximately 37,700 acres and is thirty-eight percent contained. There are currently 43 active fires. Remaining fires continue to increase in size and threaten communities and critical infrastructure. Additional resources are arriving daily. Weather conditions are currently favorable, however, significant dry conditions still pose a potential for increased fire behavior. Continued threats remain a possibility. Additional Evacuation "Warnings" and/ or "Orders" may be issued. It is anticipated that planned firing operations will continue in the Red Mountain Road, Bell Springs Road, and Blue Rock area from 6:00 PM to 12:00 AM tonight. Residents are reminded they may see increased fire and smoke in these areas.

Evacuations

Evacuation "Warnings" have been issued in:

- Greenfield Subdivision: From Fred MacMurray Lane to Main Ranch Road. From Main Ranch Road to Orr Springs Road to the Singley Ranch (12000 Orr Springs Road) –*Downgraded from "Order" at 12:00PM, June 28, 2008.*
- Community of Rockport
- Montgomery Woods/ Orr Springs Road to Running Springs Road
- Mountain View/ Mile Post 8 Area
- Red Mountain Road - From the intersection of Red Mountain Road and Bell Springs Road to 13600 Red Mountain Road.
- Bell Springs Road – From Hwy 101 to the intersection of Red Mountain Road and Bell Springs Road.
- The Community of Cummings
- Town of Leggett
- De Haven Creek and Howard Creek drainage, North of Westport
