



MENDOCINO COUNTY PYGMY TYPE SOILS IN THE COASTAL ZONE AREA

SOILS CAPABLE OF PRODUCING PYGMY VEGETATION: BLACKLOCK AND ABORIGINE SOILS
 This soils map unit is found on marine terraces. Blacklock soil is shallow to hardpan and very poorly drained. The Aborigine soil is very deep and very poorly drained.
 A delineation of this soils map unit may be made up of only one of these soils or may contain both. Included in this unit are small areas of Shinglemill and Tropaquets soils. Included areas make up about 20 percent of the total acreage. The percentage varies from one area to another.

SOILS CAPABLE OF PRODUCING PYGMY VEGETATION: SHINGLEMILL - GIBNEY COMPLEX SOILS WHICH ARE FOUND ON MARINE TERRACES AND TROPAQUETS SOILS
 Tropaquets soils are found in association with various landforms, but for purposes of this map series are limited to those Tropaquets soils found in shallow depressions on marine terraces.

Within the Shinglemill-Gibney soil complex the Shinglemill soil is very deep and poorly drained and the Gibney soil is very deep and somewhat poorly drained. This soils map unit is about 45 percent Shinglemill loam and about 35 percent Gibney loam. The two components of this unit are intricately intermingled. Included in this unit are small areas of Blacklock, Gibwell Tregoning, and Tropaquets soils. Included areas make up about 20 percent of the total acreage. The percentage varies from one area to another.

Tropaquets soils are very deep and very poorly drained. Included in this soils map unit are small areas of Aborigine, Blacklock, Shinglemill, and Tregoning soils. Included areas make up about 20 percent of the total. The percentages varies from one area to another.
